Shoe Aid is coming to your school! We are working with Nottingham City Council to deliver an education and community program in schools, before the 6 weeks holidays.

Shoe Aid exists to help the 1 in 3 children and the 250,000 homeless in the UK that are in shoe poverty. We work with major businesses, charities, schools and whole communities – and pending our exciting National re-launch; we're starting in Nottingham.

Shoe Aid, launched in 2010 by founder Lee Todd has spent recent years collecting shoes of all types, sizes and conditions and creating sustainable community and business links to enable us to grow and achieve our objectives.

- 1. There are 4 million children wearing incorrect fitting shoes right now in the UK. This will bring colossal amounts of foot related problems to the NHS over the next 10-15 years.
- 2. There are 250,000 homeless people in England. These people are at high risk of suffering trench foot which can lead to amputation.

We have the support of Keep Britain tidy to deliver a program across 18,000 schools across the UK the importance of recycling shoes.

With your support we will deliver an inclusive program to all the children in Nottingham. All children will have their feet measured in class and learn more about how important recycling is for the environment.
